This Indenture made the fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three between Samuel A Townes Esqur Commissioner of the honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and Simon Swandale of the other part Whereas George W Earle by his next friend George W Green on or about the Twenty sixth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three exhibited his bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Susan H Earle Elizabeth Earle Mary Earle Baylis Earle Grayton Earle Thomas Earle Joseph Earle and C B Stone administrator, and the cause being at issue before the honorable court came on to be heard at July term in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three when the said court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudged and decree that the lots, parcels and tracts of land described in said Bill should be sold at public auction by the commissioners of the said court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their several order, as by reference thereto in the registry of the said court will appear, and the said Samuel A Townes as Commissioner of the said court after having duly advertised the said lots, parcels and tracts of land for sale by public outcry on the fifth of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three did then openly and publicly and according to the customs of auctions sell and
