of June in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred and forty three between
William Saxon of the one part and William Bayne
of the other part Witnesseth Whereas the said William
Saxon is indebted to William Bayne in the sum of Two
Hundred and eighty four Dollars by a Seal Note in
the following words of 284. Two years after date I promise
to pay William Bayne Two Hundred and Eighty four
Dollars for value received interest to be paid annually
the said principal and the interest herein may be
paid at any time within the said three years if William
Bayne and Saxon both consent to it as witness my
hand and Seal 18th June 1863

Naw this indenture witnesseth that the said William
Saxon for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and
also in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to the said William
Saxon by William Bayne to the said William Saxon in hand
paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
William Bayne all that piece parcel and tract of Land
lying and being in or near the incorporate limits of the
Town of Greenville on the South West side of said Town
