

Henry R Williams Deed the State of South Carolina  
 To For Know all men by these presents  
 John W Grady Land that I Henry R Williams of  
 Greenville District in the State  
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Eight thousand  
 Dollars to me paid by John W Grady of Greenville District  
 in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released  
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
 the said John W Grady all that piece parcel and tract  
 of land situate lying and being in the District and State  
 aforesaid containing sixty eight acres more or less being  
 composed of two tracts or parcels of land one of which  
 contains fifty nine acres more or less was conveyed to me  
 by the Executors of John Coleman deceased by deed of February  
 14<sup>th</sup> AD 1857 and having such lines metes and bounds as the  
 plat of the same sheweth to annexed represents, and the  
 other of which containing nine acres more or less was conveyed  
 to me by David Hoke Sheriff of Greenville District by Deed of  
 July 4<sup>th</sup> AD 1859 being bounded on the South by lands of Prof J  
 Hart on the west by Dr B Manly on the North & East by the  
 Public Road, the present fence around the same being the line  
 together with all and singular the rights Member hereditam-  
 -ents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 John W Grady his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby  
 bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
 said John W Grady his heirs and assigns against me and my  
 heirs and every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof.

 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three and in the  
 Eighty seventh year of the Sovereignty & Independence of the State  
 of South Carolina— Signed sealed and delivered in the presence
