

A R McDavid Deed The State of South Carolina
 To Know all men by these presents
 William of Jenkins Lot that I Andrew R McDavid of

aforesaid in consideration of Nine thousand dollars \$9000,
 to me paid by Doctor William of Jenkins of Greenville District
 in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
 release unto the said William of Jenkins all that
 piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being within
 the corporate limits of the town of Greenville in the
 District and State aforesaid, being on the East side of
 Rutherford Street and one mile from the Court House
 containing two acres more or less and having the follow
 ing lines metes and bounds as represented by a plat
 hereto attached, Viz, beginning at a Stake on Rutherford
 Street Stones corner, and running thence E24.12 poles to
 a Stake, thence S4. E13 poles to a Stake thence W024.12 poles
 to a Stake at Rutherford Street thence with said Ruther
 ford Street N4. W013 poles to the beginning, being the same
 land conveyed by Craft to James Goodlett and by Goodlett
 to me by deed of 27th June 1863. Together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said William of Jenkins his heirs
 and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs
 Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said William of Jenkins
 his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this thirteenth day of
 October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
 sixty three and in the third year of the Independence of the Confe
 derate States of America.
