Know all men by these presents that I J L Westmoreland of the State aforesaid & district of Greenville for & in consideration of Seventy six dollars to me in hand paid by Archibald Mitchel of the same State & district have granted bargained sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Archibald his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing nineteen acres more or less Situate in Greenville District State of aforesaid being a part of the grant made to Robert Miller the 4th of December 1786 on both sides of Madams branch beginning at a white oak small 3+ on J L Westmoreland corner near Madams branch & on a small branch of Childers line running S $4\frac{1}{2}$ W 16 30 to a peach tree stump thence S $40\frac{1}{2}$ E 65 links to poplar 3+ new on the bank of Madams branch thence up the meanders of said branch about 16.20 to a stake in the fork of said branch thence S 53 E $15; 15$ to a stake corner of A Mitchells land thence N $9\frac{1}{2}$ W $41; 25$ to the beginning, Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all & singular the said premises unto the said Archibald Mitchel his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Archibald Mitchel his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
