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1856 in consideration of three thousand dollars executed to John C P Peter a deed of conveyance for the lot of land hereinbelow described and conveyed and whereas the said John C P Peter hath lost or mislaid the deed of conveyance herefor Now therefore I know all men by these presents that in order to supply the deficiency of titles for the said lot occasioned by the loss of the said deed of conveyance I the said Charles B Elford of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the premises aforesaid and of the sum of three thousand dollars paid to me as aforesaid and of the further sum of five dollars to me paid by the said John C P Peter of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
