-ation of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by James J Blakely of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James J Blakely all that tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on branches of Maple Swamp Creek branch waters of South Syger River containing one hundred and eighty one acres more or less beginning on a persimmon 340 m on the line between Greenville and Spartanburg running thence with said line N 1/3 W 45.50 chains to stake 340 m on thence N 85 1/2 W 35.29 chains to a stone 340 m thence due south 28.00 chains to stake by Red oak 340 m on thence S 59 E 19.90 chains to a stone 340 m thence S 54 1/2 E 7.66 chains to stake 340 m thence S 12 W 6.00 chains to a black oak 340 m Dead thence S 20 1/2 E 44.12 chains to a Post oak 340 m on the Greenville and Spartanburg line thence with said line N 1/3 W 41.38 chains to the beginning 340 m, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said James J Blakely his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
