 now live containing thirty two acres and a half be the same more or less  
 lying on Branches of Maple Swamp Creek Branches of South Tyger River  
 beginning on a Walnut 3+n m running thence S24 W 13.22 chs to Stake on  
 heights old line 3+n m thence S58 E 24.42 chains to Red oak 3+0 m thence N1 1/2  
 E 21.00 chains to Stake 3+n m new road thence with said road N79 1/2 W 12.36  
 chains to Stake 3+0 m in said road, thence with said road N75 1/2 W 4.26  
 chs to the beginning Walnut 3+0 m, Together with all and singular  
 the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises
