To	For	Know all men by these presents
J. N. Saylor	Land	that I Mary Ann Barton of the Greenville in the State aforesaid

in consideration of three hundred and thirty seven dollars to
me paid by J. N. Saylor of the District of Greenville in the State
aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said J. N.
Saylor a certain piece parcel of land lying on the north
side of the old Sugulo Road it being a part of a Tract of land
belonging to W. H. Barton at his death & now occupied by the
aboved named Mary Ann Barton, beginning on a Spanish
oak near the corner of the fence & being a corner of a small
piece of land sold by the said Mary Ann Barton to O
Barrett thence a straight line to a rock corner, being Saylor
& Barrett's corner thence a long Saylor's line to a large Black
oak near the Syger grave yard thence with the line of the
lot belonging to Syger Church to the said Sugulo Road thence
along said road to the beginning, containing Twenty two & a half
acres more or less, together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and
to hold full and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said J. N. Saylor his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby
bind my self my heirs executors & administrators to warrant &
defend forever all & singular the said premises unto the said
J. N. Saylor & assigns against me & my heirs & against all other
persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
