 Dollars to me paid by James P Boyce S. S. of Greenville District
 in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
 said James P Boyce two parcels or tracts of land formerly a portion
 of the real Estate of the late John T Coleman decd, situated near
 the town of Greenville in the said District and State and bounded
 as follows Viz, The first Beginning at a stake in the middle
 of the road corner of lots 8 & 6 running thence S 83 E between
 said lots 18.32 chs to a stake 34 in the line of J W Brooks thence along
 said line S 7 W 8 chs to within 16 1/2 feet of the line of a stake, thence par-
 allel with said line leaving of W Brooks a right of way 16 1/2 ft wide, S 61 1/2
 W 15 chs to a stone near large B. O thence along the Augusta road N 53 1/2 W
 6.92 chs to the middle line of New road thence along said middle line
 N 7 E 13.00 chs to the place of beginning and containing twenty four acres
