between William M Thomas Esquror Commissioner of the Honorable Court  
 of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State  
 of the one part and Edward Dill Jr of the other part Whens C<sup>r</sup> of Elford  
 and James B Sherman Executors of the last will and testament of  
 Roger Loveland deceased on or about the thirteenth day of May in  
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four exhib-  
 ited their bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court  
 House in the said State against Roger Loveland for the settlement of  
 the copartnership formerly existing between Dunham & Loveland  
 and known as such, and the cause being at issue before the honor-  
 able court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three when the said  
 court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises  
 did order adjudge and decree that said Land as owned by said firm  
 should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said  
 Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decratal  
 order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will  
 appear and the said Samuel A Lowes as Commissioner of the said  
 court after having duly advertised the said Land for sale by public  
 outcry on the sales day of November in the year of our Lord one thou-  
 sand eight hundred and fifty four did then openly and publicly  
 and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said  
 Land below described unto the said Edward Dill Jr for one hundred  
 Dollars being at that price, the highest bidder for the same. Now  
 therefore this Indenture witnesseth, that the said William M Thomas  
 as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said decree  
 and in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the  
 said Edward Dill Jr the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said Edward Dill his heirs and assigns  
 all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville  
 District on Jamisons Creek waters of South Pacolet River Known  
 as Tract No 7 in the advertisement. Together with all and singular  
 the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances to the said  
 Land belonging or in anywise appertaining. And the reversion and  
 remainders rents issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate  
 right title interest down possession property benefit claim and  
 demand whatsoever both at law and equity of the heirs and repres-  
 entatives of said Benajah Dunham and Roger Loveland and of  
 the parties to the said suit and of all other persons rightfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by from or
