The State of South Carolina  
 Know all men by these presents  
 that I Thomas Mc Coy of Greenville  
 District in the State aforesaid in con-  
 sideration of Three thousand Dollars \$3000, to me paid by  
 Martha Address of Greenville District in the State aforesaid  
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Martha Address  
 all that piece parcel and tract of land containing one hundred  
 and thirteen acres more or less situate lying and being on the  
 waters of Saluda River and on the Stanton Bridge Road about  
 four miles from Greenville Court House and in Greenville District  
 in the State aforesaid, and having the following lines, metes and  
 bounds, Viz, beginning at a P.O. 3+ near fork of White Horse, and  
 Stanton Bridge road and running thence N 67 W 23 ch to pile of  
 rocks formerly N.O. 3+ thence S 21 W 62 ch to ash 3+ at head of branch  
 thence S 69 E 6 ch to a Stake 3+ on Stanton Bridge road, thence with  
 said road as it now runs to the beginning the same having been  
 conveyed to me by Vardry Miller by deed bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day  
 of February A.D. 1863 Saving reserving and excepting the one half  
 of all the wood trees and timber upon said tract of land, to the  
 firm of Gower Cox Markley & Co to be taken off by them within  
 two years and for the full assurance of which upon said terms  
 the said Martha Address shall execute a sufficient deed to the  
 said firm, together with all and singular the rights members  
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
 or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Martha Address her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby  
 bind my self my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 Martha Address her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs  
 and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
 same or any part thereof, Subject to the reservation and exception  
 hereinbefore set forth. Witness my hand and seal this third day  
 of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and sixty four and in the 89<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the State  
 of South Carolina. Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence  
 of J. W. Wood C of Eford
