So	For	Know all men by these presents
Foster Blodgett	Pat	that we Peter Cauble & Alexander McBee of Greenville District in

the State aforesaid in consideration of One thousand Dollars to us paid by Foster Blodgett of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Foster a certain lot of land lying within or near the corporation of the Village of Greenville on the West Side of Needy River and near the Greenville & Hol N Road, on the South Side and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a Stake Nays old corner on a Street and run thence with said line South $9\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 5 chains 67 links to a Stake Nays upper corner thence N 89 degrees West 2 chains 25 links to a Stake thence N $9\frac{1}{2}$ degrees E 5 chains 67 links to the Street, Stake corner thence along said Street S 89 degrees E 2 chs 25 links to the beginning corner containing One acre & One Rod more or less being the same lot that was formerly occupied by J Keenings & purchased by us from Gower Cox & Mansely by Deed bearing date 6th Jan'y 1860 which said lot of land was deeded by the said Cauble & McBee some time in April past, but said deed is represented by the said Blodgett as being lost or mislaid & this deed is executed in lieu thereof together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, So have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Foster Blodgett his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Foster Blodgett his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
