paid by James Mc ~~Kellett~~ have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
James Mc Kellett all that plantation tract or parcel of land containing  
one hundred acres more or less situated in Greenville District and State  
aforesaid on the east side of Laurel Creek waters of Reedy River beginning on  
a poplar cor on said creek thence running with Betsy Mc Daniel's line  
185' 8 1/16 chains to an oak cor now dead. thence on Stokes line N 28 E 34 1/2  
chains to a Rock cor cor originally a pine thence N Westly on the old  
line with Stokes to a cor originally pine now a rock thence again with  
the old line S 40 W to a small white oak on said line thence leaving the  
old line South 13 chs to a black gum now dead hence S 50 E 25 1/2 to a  
pine stump thence S 32 E 3 1/2 chains to a black oak sprong standing  
on the old road to the Mill thence South 2 chains to a spring thence  
S 32 E 1 chain 70 links to a persimmon corner thence S 10 E 3 1/2 chs  
to a Rock at a branch thence down said branch to Laurel Creek  
thence down said creek to the beginning cor Poplar. Together  
with all and singular the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said James Mc Kellett his heirs and assigns forever and I do  
bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
James Mc Kellett his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs  
and assigns against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof. — Witness my hand and  
seal this 13 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and fifty four. — Signed sealed and delivered
