I James W. Johnson of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand and forty two dollars to me paid by my son Absolom Johnson and also for and in consideration of a decent and comfortable support to be furnished me by my said son Absolom Johnson for and during my natural life have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto my said son Absolom Johnson all that tract piece and parcel of land on which I reside containing Two Hundred and forty Acres more or less situated in said District on the South fork of Enore River and branches of Huddy River and containing in a grant to me from the State of South Carolina bearing date the ninth day of March A.D. 1854; beginning on a Post oak and running thence N 25 E 1/4 1/2 16 to a Pine 3/4 thence N 25 1/2 E 3/4 47 chs to a Spanish oak 3/4 thence S 89 1/2 E 1/4 88 to a Rock 3/4 thence S 55 1/4 E to a Rock 3/4 in place of a person 3/4 cut down thence down the South fork of Enore River to a Rock 3/4 thence N 85 E 2.50 to a Persimmon 3/4 thence N 54 E 8.50 to a pine 3/4 thence N 63 E to a Rock 3/4 thence N 20 1/4 E 85 to a Stake 3/4 in 73r Stout gum thence S 32 1/4 E 6.80 to a Rock 3/4 3/4 on thence S 10 1/4 E 5.98 to a Rock 3/4 thence S 37 1/2 W 28.40 to a Black oak 3/4 in old Road thence S 50 1/4 W 20.15 to a Bend in Road thence S 55 1/4 W to a Bend 10 chs. thence S 57 W 3.15 to a Bend thence S 38 1/4 W 3.36 to a Rock 3/4 thence S 61 1/2 E 7.75 to a Post oak 3/4 down thence S 59 1/2 E 21.67 to a Red oak thence S 60 1/2 W 18.00 to a Post oak 3/4 3/4 thence N 63 3/4 W 41.43 to a Rock 3/4 in place of a Black Jack thence to the beginning, bounded by lands of Edward Paull Ezekiel Barnes Philip Bishop Thomas Bruce Abraham Bates and Moses Bridges and so forth. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Absolom Johnson his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Absolom Johnson and to his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
