 Come I Charleston R McIntosh in
 the State aforesaid send greeting. Whereas I the said
 Charleston R McIntosh in and by my certain Bond or obligation
 bearing date the twentieth day of June A D 1863, conjointly
 with Judge M Duane McIntosh of Florida and William M
 Thomas of Greenville District in the State the said Judge McIntosh
 being the principal on the note and William M Thomas and my
 self sureties thereto stand firmly here and bound unto James
 B Roseman of Greenville District in this State in the penal
 sum of Two thousand Dollars conditioned for the payment of
 the full and just sum of Two thousand dollars with interest
 thereon from the 20th day of June A D 1863 payable on or before
 the 20th day of June A D 1864 (a copy of which Bond being endor-
 sed) as in and by the said bond and condition thereof refer-
 encing thereto had will manfully appear. Know
 Know all men that I the said Charleston R McIntosh in
 consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid
 and for the better securing the payment thereof, to the said
 J B Roseman according to the condition of the said Bond
 and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars
 to me the said Charleston R McIntosh in hand well
 and truly paid by the said J B Roseman and at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said
 Charleston R McIntosh have granted bargained sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release
 unto the said James B Roseman all that lot or par-
 cel of land situate lying and being in the Town of
 Greenville in the District of Greenville of this State
 on the corner of West and Whitner Streets having
 109 feet on West Street and 200 feet on Whitner Street
 adjoining lots of Mr Spear and said J B Roseman
 being the same lot conveyed by said James B Roseman
 to me by deed bearing date the 20th June A D 1863
 Together with all and singular the rights members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and
 singular the said premises unto the said J B Roseman
 and his heirs and assigns forever and I Charleston R
 McIntosh do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said J B Roseman
 and his heirs and assigns from and against my heirs execu-
 tors administrators and assigns and any one else
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent
 and meaning of these presents that if I the said Charleston
