at 1/4 E 3/4 2 1/2 to my line thence N 47 1/2 W 82 1/2 to the Spartanburg Road at John Hotchkow's corner thence with said Road to the beginning containing two acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sammie Pinckney Henry Pinckney and John Grant & their heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Sammie Pinckney Henry Pinckney and John Grant & their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and assigns and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 27 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five and in the ninth month year of the Independence of the United States of America
