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D. L. Vaughn Lease  
So of South Carolina  
W. A. Hudson Land Greenville County  
This agreement made the  
13th August 1875 between W. A. Henderson agent of Eliz-  
abeth P. Kemp guardian of R. J. W. Kemp of the  
first part and D. L. Vaughn of the second part  
witnesseth that the said W. A. Henderson agreed for  
the sum of Two hundred Dollars to lease the Mill  
tract of land containing seventy five acres for the  
term of four years unless R. J. W. Kemp dies  
before its expiration at which time this lease ends  
said Vaughn to fence the land he cultivates and  
ditch the same properly said D. L. Vaughn of the  
second part agrees to clear and ditch the following  
bottom fence the same also the upland properly  
with pay the sum of Two hundred Dollars in  
four equal instalments at the end of each year  
and will take good care of the buildings &c on  
the place said Vaughn further agrees to give a Lien  
upon the entire crop raised each year to secure  
the payment of the aforesaid fifty Dollars each  
year hereinafter provided for by Note and Lien  
to W. A. Henderson said Lease to go into effect the  
1st January 1876

with last link 1 Ch 68 links to stake on Mulberry Street  
thence with Mulberry Street fifty feet to the beginning -

aments and appurtenances to the said premises in anywise  
incident or appertaining I have and do hold all  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
Trustees of the said African Methodist Episcopal Church  
their associates and assigns forever And I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to  
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Trustees their associates and  
assigns against myself and my heirs and every other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof
