 thousand nine hundred and thirteen undivided nine thou-
 sandths of all that plantation or tract of land situated lying
 and being in the County of Georgetown in the said State
 known as "Guendaloss" described as "all that Plantation
 known as "Guendaloss" (including the "Retreat" or "Bullens"
 Island" and "Polly Hill") situate lying and being in the
 County of Georgetown and State aforesaid described in the
 conveyance thereof by Plowden Charles Junet Weston to
 Benjamin Allston bearing date the first day of January A.D.
 1859 as "all that plantation in the Parish of Prince George
 on both sides of the Pee Dee River, Butting and bounding to
 the North on lands of the Honorable R. G. W. Allston,
 Chapel Cross Long Cross and Wood's Passo to the East
 on Waccamaw River, to the South on Riquelme Cross
 Bullens Lake, and lands of Mrs. Jane Barnwell and
 to the West on "The Globe" and lands of the said R. G. W.
 Allston, containing by Estimation about Twelve hun-
 dred and fifty Acres, and three quarters of an acre (1250 3/4
 A) consisting of three tracts heretofore called or known by
 the name of Guendaloss, Retreat and Heally Hills
