 Creek branch Waters of Red River and bounded by lands
 of Mrs. South and myself Beginning on a Red oak Stump
 3x0m and running thence N 88 1/2 W 22.80 c to a Stone 3x0 m
 thence S 2 1/2 E 27.00 c to a Stone 3x 9 m on old line thence S
 3 1/8 E 35.40 c to the beginning. Together with all and singular
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the
 premises before mentioned unto the said Abraham Green
 his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself
 and my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Abra-
 ham Green and his heirs and assigns against myself and
