Know all men by these presents that
I Alfred Fuller in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Four hundred Dollars to me in
hand paid at and by the seal and of these presents by W A
Hudson in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby
unwitnessed) have granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
W A Hudson all that tract or parcel of land situated in the
County of Greenville State aforesaid in the Spartanburg Road
1 1/2 miles East of the City of Greenville containing Eight Acres
more or less and hath such marking bounds & eas follows viz:
Beginning on a P O 3 x 0 thence N 72 E along said Road 5 1/5 to a
P O 3 x 0 thence N 35 E 1.20 to a R C 3 x 0 thence N 67 1/4 W
with Morris line 19.55 to a Stone 3 x 12 thence S 30 1/2 E 8.25 to a
large W A 3 x 2 below Spring thence S 42 E 6.15 to the
beginning, Together with all and singular the rights and
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
ing or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and
to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said W A Hudson his heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said W A Hudson his heirs and
assigns, against myself and my heirs and all others law-
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,

year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
seventy six and in the 101st year of the sovereignty and
Independence of the United States of America
