Whereas the copartnership

by its own limitation, and whereas upon a settlement of the
copartnership affairs, the said William D. Godwin
agreed to take the Real Estate of said firm. Now therefore
know all men by these presents that I the said Alfred
Fuller of Greenville County in the state aforesaid, in con-
sideration of the premises and of the sum of Five Dollars to
me paid by the said William D. Godwin at and before
the execution of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby ack-
nowledged, have granted bargained sold and released and
do hereby grant bargain sell and release unto the said
William D. Godwin "all my right title interest and estate
of, in or to all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying
and being in the City and County of Greenville and State
of South Carolina containing sixteen $\frac{1}{100}$ hundredths of an
acre more or less, and having the following lines meters
and bounds to wit: Beginning at an Iron Pin on corner
Main Street and running thence N 79 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 29 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to an
Iron Pin 32 m on S W Davis line, thence with said line
N 71 W 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to Laurens Street, thence S 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 29 $\frac{1}{4}$
feet to an Iron Pin 32 m on what was formerly M^{rs} Pies
