I know all men by these presents that I James Henderson of the State and County aforesaid in consideration of the

sum of Five Hundred dollars to me paid by James K. McClellan of Laurens County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James K. McClellan all that plantation or tract of land in Greenville County containing One hundred and twenty two acres 1133/ more or less situate in this County aforesaid lying on the waters of Reedy River Beginning on the west corner 3x in the fork of Branch and Little Horse Creek running thence up said branch \$5.5. 183.90 to a Red Oak 3x three 1.80 W^N to a Post Oak 3x Binding on S. W. 1/4. Then E. 344. W. 140.7 to a Post oak 3x three 1.10 W 15 to a Sweet Gum 3x three 1.28 N to a Stake 3x three 1.20 W 473 to a maple 3x on the branch and binding on J. H. Ware. Thence up the meanderings of Little Branch \$14.50 to a White Oak 13x at the head of said branch thence \$33. E. 9.25 to a Post oak 13x bounded by Wm. Ellison line N. 473. E. 36.40 to a white Oak 3x on the laurens line thence S. 14.10 to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James K. McClellan his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs and executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James K. McClellan his heirs and assigns forever against myself, my heirs and every other person or persons whomever may lawfully or unlawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
