Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

I do have and do hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said W^t R. Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever; and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W^t R. Sullivan his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
