And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said Robert W. Morris, his heirs and assigns against myself, and my heirs, and every other person whatsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this sixth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty seven and in the one hundred and first year of the Independence of the United States of America.
