I, John L. Southern Sheriff of  
Greenville County, and State

of said, said Greuling; whereas, by virtue of a writ of  
Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for  
the County of Greenville, dated the twelfth day of April, in the year  
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy six, at the  
suit of W. T. Shumate against J. K. Jenkins to me directed, com-  
manding me that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenement
