Thompson a certain tract piece or parcels of land situate in the County and State aforesaid on Guano Branch water of Reedy River containing 117 1/2 Beginning at a point near the Deaky Ferry Road opposite of Trinity Academy thence N 22 1/2 W 40.33 to Station M in the by the head thence N 61 1/2 W 26.55 to Post Oak x m thence S 26 1/2 W 40 to confluence x m of the Guano and Lost Spring Branches thence by the meanders of the Guano Branch to stone x m 44 near the spring thence S 48 to E 11.75 to the beginning Post Oak x m Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Margaret A. Thompson and David T. Thompson and their heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular said premises unto the said Margaret A. Thompson and David T. Thompson their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,
