 To all to whom these presents shall come,
 I Perry D Gilchrist, Sheriff of Greenville
 County, and State aforesaid, send greeting,
 Whereas, by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of
 Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the nineteenth day
 of April in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
 seventy eight at the suit of J. C. Gower & Company to me directed, com-
 manding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of W. A.
 Henderson to levy the sum of Eight hundred and seven $\frac{4}{5}$ Dollars damages
 and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said
 W. A. Henderson, or his interest in all that certain piece, parcel and tract
 of land, and building acres more or less, situate and lying
 in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, on Washington Street
 in the City of Greenville, and known as the City Ware house
 And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure
 by me made, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned,
 have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Miss
 L. B. Marshall of the County of Greenville in the State of South
 Carolina for the sum six dollars being the highest sum that was
 bidden therefor. Now know ye, that I Perry D Gilchrist, Sheriff aforesaid,
 by virtue of said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed
 and delivered, as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case
 made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of six
 dollars to me in hand paid, or deemed to be paid by the said Miss L. B.
 Marshall the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have
 granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and
 sell unto the said Miss L. B. Marshall her heirs and assigns forever, the
 said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the
 estate right title and interest which the said W. A. Henderson of right
 had, or in and to the same; To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and
 tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Miss L. B. Marshall
 her heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said
 Perry D Gilchrist might could or ought to grant, bargain and
 sell the same, by virtue of the Statute aforesaid, and the said writ
 of fieri facias, or otherwise.

 by the written agreement hereinafter
 dated A. D. Hooke and William Beattie
 of the first part and William Williman of the second part, have this day
 bargained and sold, to the said William Williman of the second part, a
 certain lot of land in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid,
 and commonly known as the "Jane Casey place" said property sold
 subject to the following itemised agreement between the aforementioned
 parties, 1st The property as a whole is to be paid for by the said
 2nd party in the sum of Five hundred Dollars said sum payable as
 follows: One hundred Dollars in cash on signing of this agreement
 Two hundred Dollars by Note of hand payable One year from date of
 this paper with interest on same at eight per cent per annum.
 One note payable two years from date of this paper with interest on
 same at eight per cent per annum. 2nd The said William
 Williman to hold and occupy the said property, he paying all
 the taxes that may accrue on said property, and complying
 with the aforesaid or aforementioned article of agreement, free and
 un molested by the said first party. 3rd The said first party
 A. D. Hooke and William Beattie hereby pledge themselves, that
 upon the full performance and compliance of the said second
 party William Williman to them and their Executrix to him the said
 Wm. Williman full and complete titles for the said lot of land
 known as the "Jane Casey place".
