Three hundred Dollars to us paid by Harriet Hightower of Greenville
County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Harriet Hightower, all of our right, title and interest, in
that certain piece parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and
being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, adjoining
lands of David Adams, Perry Robertson and others, and containing
Ninety six and a half Acres, more or less sold by us as the
property of Elizabeth Watson, deceased, for division among the
heirs of said deceased. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said Harriet Hightower her heirs and assigns forever and
we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Harriet Hightower her heirs and assigns, against
us and our heirs, and every other person or persons lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

come or be made known, or whom
the same may in anywise concern,

I S J Doullitt Probate Judge of the County of Greenville in the
said State and greeting. Whereas, W A McDaniel administrator
of the Estate of J Franklin Sullivan deceased on or about the 11th
day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and
seventy eight did exhibit his complaint in the Court of Probate
at Greenville Court House in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
against Beattie or Mrs. Nellie E Sullivan, W E Sullivan
George Sullivan Harold A Sullivan, Benjamin A Sullivan, Nellie
E Sullivan, Mary D Sullivan, and Matt D Sullivan. And the
cause being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came
on to be heard on the 22nd day of June one thousand eight
hundred and seventy eight when the said Court after a full
hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did
order, adjudge and decree that the tract of land belonging to the
Estate of J Franklin Sullivan deceased hereinafter mentioned &
described, should be sold at public Auction, by the Probate Judge
of Greenville County, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned
in the said Decreeal order, as by reference thereto, on file in the
said Court, will appear; and the said Probate Judge after having duly
advertised the said tract of land for twenty one days for sale
by public outcry, on the fourth day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight
did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of
Auction, sell and dispose of the said tract of land below
described, unto George W Anderson for Five hundred Dollars
he being, at that price, the highest bidder for the same.

Now know all men, that I, the said S J Doullitt Probate Judge
of Greenville County in consideration of the premises, and also
in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars paid me by
the said George W Anderson the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said George W Anderson and his heirs and assigns, that
tract of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on waters of Green River
adjoining lands of George Anderson & New and others and con-
taining One hundred and forty seven and three fourth acres
or less, known as the division of the real estate of J Franklin
Sullivan deceased as tract No 4. Together with all and
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
whatsoever, to the said tract of land belonging, or in
anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders
rights issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate
right title interest dower possession property benefit claim
