come: I Perry D Gilreath, Sheriff
of Greenville County, and State

of said, and greeting: whereas, by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias
issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of
Greenville, dated the thirtieth day of July in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight at the suit of Linear
Linden and others Administrators of Sam Sumner to me directed
commanding me, that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of
L.R. Ferguson & Mary E Whitman to levy the sum of Four hundred and
seventy nine dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken
of the lands and tenements of the said Mary E Whitman's interest in
all that certain piece, parcel & tract of land, containing one and
one fourth acres more or less, situate and being in the County of

Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to
me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute
in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration
of the said sum of Five hundred and ten Dollars to me in hand
paid, or secured to be paid, by the said Whitman & Good the receipt
and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the
said Whitman & Good their heirs and assigns forever the said
tract piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all
the estate right title and interest which the said Mary E Whit-
man of right had, of, in and to the same: To have and to
hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurten-
ances, unto the said Whitman & Good their heirs and assigns forever
as fully and absolutely, as if the said Perry D Gilreath might could or
ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute
aforesaid, and the said writ of Fieri Facias, or otherwise.
