

were composed of himself, and other parties last above-named, certain other lots, pieces or parcels of land in and near the said City of Greenville, and County and State aforesaid; and were particularly described in said agreement; and that the said parties who were interested in the lands above mentioned, in order to facilitate the sale and transfer of said lands, had agreed to and amongst themselves, to convey all of the lands in trust, to two of them number to sell and divide the proceeds of sale among the parties, according to their respective interests; and prayed amongst other things that these matters might be inquired into, and if found advisable to carry out the said agreement in reference to a trust deed, that a suitable trust deed be reported, together with some suitable person or persons; and whereas, upon the said cause being heard, on the 17th day of June A.D. 1874 it was referred to a special referee, to report on the various matters embraced in the pleadings in said cause, and upon the report of said special referee coming in, containing the various recommendations therein more fully set forth, it was on the 7th day of August A.D. 1874 amongst other things, ordered that Whittier Symmes and Thomas le Gower, be appointed Trustees, to whom William A. McDowell Clerk of the said Court, should convey the said lands, to have and to hold the same, to, for and upon the purposes, uses and trusts, as aforesaid and declared in the deeds reported by the said referee, and whereas, the said William A. McDowell Clerk aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said trustees. Now therefore know all men by these presents, that we, Thomas le Gower and Whittier Symmes Trustees as aforesaid, by virtue of the power conferred upon us, in and by the order and trust deed aforesaid upon the written request of the trustees give trust hereon endorsed, and in performance of our duty as such trustees and also in consideration of the sum of One hundred and five Dollars, to us paid by Thomas H. Walker before the delivery of these presents, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas H. Walker all that piece parcel or lot of land being parcels of the lands above mentioned situate and lying in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, commencing at a stake on Cross street running thence S 4 1/4 E one hundred feet to a stake corner of lot No fourteen thence N 85 1/2 W one hundred and fifty feet to a stake on street thence along street N 4 1/2 W one hundred feet to a stake on street thence along street S 85 1/2 W one hundred and fifty feet to the beginning corner containing one Rod and fifteen perches more or less and known in Dickson's Survey as lot Number thirteen together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Thomas H. Walker his heirs and assigns forever freed from and discharged of all further trusts whatsoever. And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas H. Walker his heirs and assigns against us and our

heirs and every other person, whomever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, through and under us, as trustees aforesaid.
