One hundred and forty six \$146.00 dollars to me paid by Perry  
Davis of the County of Greenville in the aforesaid State have  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Perry Davis a certain tract  
piece or parcel of land in the County of Greenville in the aforesaid  
State on both sides of the North Fork of Fall Creek waters  
of the North Fork of Saluda River - the land on the North  
West side of said Creek is part of a tract of land conveyed to  
Daniel Pace the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July 1844 by J. A. Leland Super-  
intendent of Public works &c. and by said Pace to me, begin-  
ning on a Chestnut ox (corner of John Ellege Grant) thence N 68  
W 13.50 chains to a stake ox in place of Chestnut corner of  
John Ellege Grant thence N 18 E 16.50 chains to a White Oak ox on  
branch and corner of York Grant thence N 68 E 13.50 chains  
to a Spanish oak ox (diver) and station on line of York Grant  
thence N 56 E 6.60 chains to a Hickory ox thence N 72 E 6.85 chains  
to a large rock ox on bank of creek in old mill pond place  
thence S 76 E 5.90 chains to a large rock ox on side of moun-  
tain thence S 16 W 13.75 chains to a Dogwood ox thence S  
83 1/4 W 8.80 chains to a cottonwood ox on the bank of the creek  
thence down the meanders of said creek 22.85 chains to

Lynn ox (down) on the bank of the creek at the rocky ford thence
