Assignment

The State of South Carolina  
Know all men by these presents  
that I Louis A. Kettle Jr of the City  
of Greenville in the County of

J. M. Westmoreland

Greenville and State aforesaid am indebted to divers persons in consid-  
erable sums of money which I am unable to pay in full, and being  
desirous of conveying all of my property in merchandise for the benefit  
of my creditors. Now therefore I Louis A. Kettle in consideration of  
the moneys, and of one dollar to me paid by Jesse M. Westmoreland  
of said City, County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged, have granted bargained sold assigned and transferred  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell assign transfer and  
deliver unto the said Jesse M. Westmoreland all of my stock  
of Dry goods Lamp goods, glass ware, crockery and other goods  
wares and merchandise, with all of my notes, accounts and other  
chores in action appertaining to said business and belonging to  
me the said Louis A. Kettle Jr. To have and to hold the same  
unto the said Jesse M. Westmoreland in trust to sell and dispose  
of said stock and to collect said rights of action, with power to  
compromise for said rights of action, taking a part for the whole  
where the said Jesse M. Westmoreland shall deem it expedient  
so to do, and then in trust to apply the proceeds of said property  
and rights of action as follows:

- I To pay Carl Wells & Westmoreland attorneys at Law the sum of fifty dollars for counsel advice and legal services, and to pay the lawful expense of executing the trust hereby created
- II To my state and County taxes whatever they may be if any,
- III To pay Simon Durandale one hundred & seventy seven dollars for above rent for about 5 1/2 months,
- IV To pay Henry F. Kettle for services as above in my store for five months at twenty Dols a month, one hundred dollars,
- V To pay Dr O. B. Irvine forty & 00/100 Dollars for rent of house for about 5 1/2 months at twelve & 00/100 Dols a month,
- VI To distribute the remainder of said proceeds in payment of the debts of me the said Louis A. Kettle; provided that if there shall not be sufficient funds with which to pay
