State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars,
to me in hand paid by Alice Harrison of Greenville County in
the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
Alice Harrison one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid on both sides of the Gap Creek Road
joining lands with Wright and Wilson, James Harrison, Benj Harrison
or Nancy Ponder and others beginning corner at a red oak thence
across the branch to a rock thence across said branch to a stake
thence a straight line to a pine on James Harrison line thence to the
Creek to a stake thence up the Creek to a stake thence a straight line
to a post oak on the line between myself and Benj Harrison thence
a straight line to a Chestnut on the head of a branch a straight
line to the top of Paeks Mountain thence a straight line to the top
of Busstall hill to a post oak thence a straight line to a chestnut corner
on the Gap Creek road thence a straight line to the red oak the begin-
ning corner containing three hundred and eighty eight and a
half acres more or less, also all my stock of horses cattle hogs
and sheep, together with all my household and kitchen furniture together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appur-
tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incid-
ent or appertaining, do have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Alice Harrison her heirs
and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said real and personal property above mentioned
unto the said Alice Harrison her heirs and assigns against me and
my heirs and against every person or persons whatsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me
paid by William Choice Junior of Greenville in the said State have
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant
bargain sell and release, unto the said William Choice Junior all
that tract of land lying and being in the District of Greenville and State
aforesaid on the waters of Richland Creek beginning at a post oak corner
and running 647.00 to a small hickory near the old road to Spartanburg,
thence 843.00 to a sowerwood on the bank of the Tan Yard branch
thence up the meanders of said branch, excepting what Judge Thompson
conveyed to David Keuning at the Tan Yard, say about one acre 70 as
white oak some short distance above the Tan Yard, and thence North 11 66.85
to the beginning and also, excepting out of the above described tract about four
acres sold off by me and conveyed to Mrs Mary Allston which is taken off
at the west end of the said tract, all the balance I hereby give and convey to
the said William Choice Jun^r being a tract conveyed to me by Waddy
Thompson Sen^r by deed dated the 11th day of April 1818. Together with
all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, do
have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the
said William Choice Jr. heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the said William
Choice his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs only.
