Know all men by these presents
that we Nimrod Grayham,
James J Grayham John Grayham
and Nancy L Grayham all of said State and County are
held and firmly bound unto Clemmon and Elizabeth Grayham in
the sum of Three Thousand Dollars good and lawful money of
said State the payment of which well and truly to be made we bind
ourselves our heirs and assigns jointly and severally if we shall fail in the
condition under written signed with our names and sealed with our seals
the twenty first day of April one thousand eight hundred and seventy
nine Now the condition of the above bond is such that whereas the
said Clemmon has executed a Deed for a certain tract of land contain-
ing Thirty three & one fourth acres to the said Nimrod Grayham
and deed for a tract of land containing Thirty five acres to J J Grayham
and deed for a certain tract of land for Thirty eight acres to John
and Nancy L Grayham. Now the said Parties agree that Clemmon
Grayham and Elizabeth Grayham shall have a life interest in
said tracts of land and the said Parties viz Nimrod Grayham James
J Grayham John & Nancy L Grayham are to pay annually one
fourth of all the crops raised on said tracts of land to the said Clemmon
& Elizabeth Grayham for their support during their natural lives and
to furnish them firewood and take care of them while they or either
of them shall live to pay the taxes on said lands and further that the
said parties agree to take good care of the said Clemmon and
Elizabeth Grayham during their natural lives of either of them
and at the death of the said Clemmon and Elizabeth Grayham
the parties before mentioned shall have full possession of said
tracts of land and also of all the property either Real or personal
that the said Clemmon and Elizabeth Grayham may have
or own at their death to be divided equally between them
provided each one of the parties to these presents shall do
them part and should either of them fail in performing their
parts the ones that perform their parts shall have all
the property mentioned above and those failing shall have
no part in the property before mentioned

of Said State & County for and in consideration of the love and affec-
tion which I bear to my son James J Grayham of said State and
County have given granted and by these presents do give grant and
release unto the said J J Grayham for and during his natural
life and after his death to be equally divided between his children
all that tract of land situated in the County aforesaid on Horse Creek
waters of Reedy River bounded by lands of A. B. Stepp, J J Grayham
and tract No 4 Beginning at stone running S 42 E 2.36 to stone thence
S 33 E 0.92 to stake thence N 62 W 15.39 to stone thence N 08 W 3.86 to
stone thence N 37 W 10.58 to stone thence N 05 W 4.15 to N. O. thence
N 7.1 E 6.75 to W. O. thence N 80 E 9.00 to Beginning again containing
Thirty five acres more or less being part of tract No 1 deeded
to Elizabeth Smith and Edwin Smith which deed they forfeited
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in anywise appur-
taining. To have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said
James J Grayham for and during his natural life and after his
death to his children forever, and I bind myself my heirs and
assigns to warrant and forever defend the said tract of land
unto the said James J Grayham as aforesaid during his natural
life and after his death to his children. Nevertheless it is under-
stood that Clemmon Grayham and Elizabeth Grayham shall have
a life interest in said tract of land and also the said James J Gray-
ham agrees to pay annually one fourth of the crops raised on
said tract of land to the said Clemmon and Elizabeth Grayham
for their support during their natural lives and their death the
foregoing title to vest as directed
