bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Bettie E Murray all that
piece, parcel, or lot of land situate lying and being in the
County of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, containing three
acres more or less and bounded as follows:— Beginning at a
stake corner of Hudson and — Streets and running
thence with Hudson Street S 21 W 3.75 c to a stake on
Reedy River, thence S 35 E 2.60 to a stake, thence S 37 1/2 E 2.68 chains
to a stake, thence S 31 E 2 chains to a stake, thence S 31 1/2 E 1.54
chains to a stake, thence N 3 1/2 E 8 chains to a stake on —
Street, thence with said Street N 56 1/2 W 4.94 chains to the
