Pickens County in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection I have and bear to my wife, and for the sum of one hundred Dollars to me paid by Elvira Robinson of Pickens County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elvira Robinson all of my right title and interest to all that piece parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in the County of Greenville State aforesaid on Saluda River joining lands of John Waldrop, Wiley Bishop, Mays and others and containing twenty seven hundred Acres more or less - The same being known as the "Osagers Head" tract, and upon which "Osagers Head tract" is situated. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elvira Robinson her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Elvira Robinson her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
