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of Greenville in the State aforesaid am indebted to diverse persons in considerable sums of money which I am unable to pay in full, and am desirous of conveying of all of my stock of merchandise &c for the benefit of my creditors: Now therefore I Columbus J Hunt in consideration of the premises and of one dollar to me paid by Louis O Dargan of said City County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold assigned and transferred & by these presents do grant bargain sell assign transfer and deliver unto the said Louis O Dargan all of my stock of Dry Goods, Boots, Shoes, clothing, notions and all other goods, wares and merchandise, with all of my notes, accounts and other choses in action, appertaining to said business and belonging to me the said Columbus J Hunt in trust to sell and dispose of said stock and to collect said moneys with power to compound for said rights

of action, taking a part for the whole when the said Louis O. Dargan shall deem it expedient so to do, and then in trust to apply the proceeds of said property and rights of action as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> To pay Carle Wells & Westmoreland my attorneys Fifty Dollars for their services hereon. 2<sup>nd</sup> To pay off a judgment against me in the name of Wm C Carle, now held by Wm Perry. 3<sup>rd</sup> To pay the balance pro rata amongst my creditors after meeting and paying the expenses of litigating the right of W Whitton or of Bates Reed and Cooley to enforce a chattel mortgage, which they claim to hold against me on my stock of merchandise. Provided that the acceptance of a pro rata under this assignment shall be in full of said claims & demands.
