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aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said B H Barbour all that tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on waters of Gibbers Creek, adjoining lands of Josiah Bramlett, John Johnson and others, and containing fifty seven and three fourth acres, more or less being the same tract of land conveyed to me by the Sheriff of Greenville County, by deed bearing date the 4th of November 1878 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said B H Barbour his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said B H Barbour his heirs and assigns, against one and my heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
