fifty Dollars to us paid by the Trustees of the  
Washington Street Presbyterian Church of Greenville  
in the District and State of aforesaid, via Whitford  
Smith Sen & Logan B. Cline Benjamin Gars John  
Adams and Charles B. Stone have granted bargain-  
ed sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Trustees of the said Church all that piece parcel  
and tract of land situated in the South-west  
portion of the corporate limits of the town of  
Greenville near the Fair Road & dep. beginning  
at a stake & on Wadry Street and running with  
said street 87 1/2 feet to a stake & then

wide thence along said street N 20 3/4 W 240 feet to a  
stake & on a stake 50 feet wide running S 26 1/2 W thence  
along the said street S 26 1/2 W 243 feet to the beginning  
corner containing 11 Poles more or less  
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises belong-  
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and  
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
