to the same more or less and bounded as follows: begin-

running thence N 74 1/4 E 45.35 chs to a Rock ox 0.25

31.90 chs to a Cherry tree 3 x m on the East side of the
White Horse Road thence with the white Horse Road
as a line to the beginning white Oak corner. Together
with all and singular the rights, incidents, appendant
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to
