 Calab Benson all that a certain piece or tract
 of Land lying and being in Sumner County and
 State of Georgia are waters of Siler's Creek, waters of
 Bruce River being a portion of a certain tract of
 Land deed to the said B. S. Hamby deceased Febri-
 ary 20, 1873. Beginning as a Rock measuring three
 1/2 ft N 21 to P. O. 3+ and thence N 19 W 13 3/4 to a rock
 3+ and thence N 48 E 1400 to Rock 3+ and thence N 41
 E 662 to a Rock and thence S 34 1/2 E 2000 to the Be-
 ginning corner containing thirty two acres more
 or less together with all and singular the Rights
 Members Appurtenances and appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appurtenant. To have and to hold all and sing-
 ular the said premises before mentioned unto the
 said Calab Benson & his heirs & assigns forever
