Jones her heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary Jones her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and all their lawful claimings or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty and in the one hundred and fifth Year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
