 and released and by these Presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said James M. Langley his
 heirs and assigns forever all that tract or lot of
 land situate lying and being in the County and
 State aforesaid commencing at a stone corner 3+3+
 new mark by Post Oak stump on settlement Road
 and running along said Road to a Maple 3+3+0 on
 one branch thence down the branch to an Ash 3+3+
 on thence S 70 1/4 W 7.46 to a Poplar on a branch
 thence up the branch to a Poplar 3+3+0 on thence
 S 56 1/4 W 6.85 to a Hickory 3+3+0 on thence N 52 1/2 E 5.76
 to a lightwood stake in branch 3+3+0 on thence N 63 1/2
 W 16.50 to the Beginning corner. Containing one hun-
 dred and forty six acres as represented upon a
 plat made by J. N. Southern D. S. 3rd day of June 1874
 together with all and singular the Rights Members
