

between himself and D. M. Davis situated on the west side of Main Street Greenville S. C. the location of the said wall to be the line between them.

D. M. Davis agrees to pay to W. L. Mauldin one half of the cost of this joint wall with the privilege of using said wall for the purpose of erecting a fence three (3) feet high and in case W. L. Mauldin shall use that portion of the wall so erected by D. M. Davis he shall account to D. M. Davis for one half of the cost of the part of the wall so used.

D. M. Davis agrees to take care of the water that falls upon his roof and not to allow it to cause expense for property of W. L. Mauldin.

W. L. Mauldin consents for D. M. Davis to open windows for the purpose of lights but D. M. Davis waives any right or privilege thereof and admits the right of W. L. Mauldin to close the same by building at any time.

D. M. Davis agrees to allow W. L. Mauldin to run the water which shall fall upon his buildings by pipes through the property of said D. M. Davis into Lawrence Street.

It is further agreed by and between the parties to this agreement that all the provisions and covenants in this agreement shall apply with equal force and effect to the heirs assigns administrators or executors of the parties to this agreement.
