(\$15.00) to me in hand paid by Allen Gosnell & President D Gos-
nell of Greenville County in the State of aforesaid. Have granted
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Allen Gosnell and
President D Gosnell a tract piece of parcel of land lying and
being situate in Greenville County in the State of aforesaid on
Branch waters of Mush Creek South Upper River and is
part of the tract of land known as the Alfred Turner tract
and granted to me by grant dated April 15th 1840
and runs as follows i.e. beginning on a stone & thence
with William Dilleys line to a stone & thence across
a creek to a stone & thence to a chestnut & thence
to a stone & near the creek thence to the beginning
stone & containing five acres more or less and bounded
by lands of myself and others Together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold, all and sing-
ular the said premises before mentioned unto the said
Allen Gosnell and President D Gosnell their heirs
and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Allen Gosnell and President D Gosnell
their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and
all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof.

and President Davis Gosnell of Greenville County in the State
aforsaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have
granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Allen
Gosnell Willborne Gosnell and President Davis Gosnell
a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying and being
situate in Greenville County and State of aforesaid on Branch
of Mush Creek waters of South Upper River and known
as the G. Benson Mill tract containing sixteen acres
more or less and runs as follows Beginning on a white
Oak & on a Bluff thence S 69 1/4 to a chestnut & by
a Rock thence N- a conditional line to a stake & in corner
of old field on Wm Dilleys line thence with said Dilleys
line E to a stone & thence N 52 E to a Red Oak & thence
S 86 E 4 25 chains to a Red Oak & thence S 35 7/8 E 2 24 chains
to the beginning W Oak & bounded by lands of Turner
& Morris Turner Lafayette and Wm Dilley Together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
