five Dollars to me paid by Mrs J. A. Hightower
of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have
granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Mrs J. A. Hightower all his undivided
right title and interest of in or to certain River
land situate lying and being in Greenville County
containing one hundred and sixty five acres
given bequeathed and devised to me and my two brothers
by my father the late William K. Hightower in the
fifth clause of his last will and testament, dated
the 19th day of January 1871 also my entire
right title and interest of in or to all and singular
the residue of the lands devised and given me by
my said father in his said last will and testament
and his undivided interest in the same

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said undivided prem-
ises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
before mentioned unto the said Mrs J. A. Hightower her
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my-
self my heirs executors and administrators to
warrant and forever defend all and singular the
said premises unto the said Mrs J. A. Hightower
