Doacham of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by John A. Dill of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John A. Dill all that certain piece parcel or tract of lands situate lying and being in the County of Greenville about twelve and a half miles from Greenville Court House on Pinecreek Road beginning at the crossing of Pinecreek and Mill Roads and running thence N 35 1/2 E 110 or chs to a bend in said Pinecreek Road; thence N 29 1/2 E 13.30 chs with said road to another bend in Road; thence N 8 1/4 W 9.36 chs across the creek to a stake in middle of said Pinecreek Road corner of ...
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chs to a stone 3x 3 m; thence S 28 1/2 W 26.10 chs to a stone on side of said Mill Road 1.59 chs from ...
thence S 64 1/4 E 16.81 chs to the beginning corner containing fifty and one half acres more or less also one other tract of land situated in Greenville County about one half mile from above tract beginning at a stone 3x 3 m corner of Watsons and Griffiths land and running thence S 12 3/4 W 18.53 to a stone 3x 3 m on side of Road thence with said road S 87 1/2 E 8.66 chs to stone 3x 3 m thence S 80 E 3.24 chs to stake 3x 3 m; thence S 38 1/2 E 11.81 chs across Bridwell bridge to a stone in middle of Road; thence N 38 1/2 E 12.50 chs to a Poplar 3x 3 m at the mouth of a gully; thence N 60 W 5.08 chs to a Red Oak 3x 3 m thence N 52 W 24.23 chs the beginning corner containing thirty one 20/100 acres more or less

Dill his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John A. Dill his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
