To all to whom these pres-
ents shall come: J. Perry
D. Gilreath Sheriff of Green-

ville County, and State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas
by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the
Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of
Greenville, tested the nineteenth day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and eighty at the suit of Henry Springfield to me di-
rected, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels
lands and tenements of G. B. Carter Adm'r of Catharine
Tinsley dead to levy the sum of One hundred & 2^d
seventy eight ⁹/₁₀₀ Dollars damages and costs,
I have seized and taken of the lands and
tenements of the said G. B. Carter Adm'r of Catha-
rine Tinsley deceased all that certain piece, parcel
and tract of land, containing twenty six acres
more or less situate and lying in the County of
