Mc Green all that tract part or piece of land situate in Greenville County and State of South Carolina on the branch waters of Laurel Creek about five miles and one half from Greenville County House (beginning at a Rock corner of Jackson Ponds thence N 28 3/4 W 9 chs to a Persimmon x 0 m in branch washed up thence S 61 1/4 W 16.65 chs to a Rock x N 111 thence S 28 3/4 E 9 chs to a W O x n thence N 61 1/4 E 16.75 chs to the beginning containing Fifteen Acres be it the same more or less and bounded by lands of Jackson Ponds, said Austins and Green and more particular known by a survey made by H. P. Johnson City Sur and Engr the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December 1881.) Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said L. R. Mc Green her heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said L. R. Mc Green and her heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
